 Say "and" or "next" between cards. Add another card for framework (soft a hire "apple") or something to fill up the 35 seconds you have left.

EX - Make your points to the judge, not your opponents - face me. Kieran is fielding too many questions.

NC - Some sweet evidence on case, but on my God is this politics shell atrocious. The strongest claim your internal (C) evidence makes is that the "jobs bill does "more economic harm than good"... which gets us to economic collapse, uh, how exactly? "winners win" is an awful generic (C). ~~winners win~~

EX - First question should be status of (C). Too many softball questions/questions that indicate you need to work on flowing. This time should be used to poke holes & set yourself up strategically.

AC - Try to generate some offense on Politics. You need to read more than just "perm-do (C)" on the (C). Answer Earth sciences. Case should come first. Try to stick to your roadmap, signpost where you are at all times, & minimize jumping back & forth. Almost every problem with this speech could be solved by some work on flowing - you should have a clearer idea which arguments belong on which flows & be answering everything.

NC - Discuss the interaction between your econ impact & theirs. Good politics coverage, but you need to answer their "we (C) by (C)ing war" arg on-point & you need more impact calc, which needs to be more comparative. Jack, FLOW




